How to Nominate

To nominate a candidate for the WFIA Community Service Award, complete the back of this form and return it to WFIA by February 1, 2017. It is important to provide complete answers to each question and to include as much information as possible. Add pages to this application to include newspaper clippings and articles if available, and contact the nominee's family for additional information.

Eligibility

The nominee's company must be a current dues-paying member of WFIA. To find out if a specific candidate is a WFIA member, please call Leah at 360-753-5177 ext. 3. Honorees should attend the WFIA Industry Reception to receive the award.

Selection

The number of awards given in any specific year is at the discretion of the WFIA Board. Directors will review nominations, vote on entries, and determine the number of honorees to be recognized.

Recognition

Recipients will be notified in March or April 2017. A press release and media event will be scheduled in advance to announce the award.

Final honorees will be featured in a special e-alert, in the President's e-newsletter, and on wa-food-ind.org.

Although the grocery store is a key institution within the community, often at the center of community and charity events, it takes individuals who volunteer their time and efforts to really make a difference.

This award honors an individual who makes a significant difference in their community through their volunteer service.

Examples of community service include, but not limited to:

- Volunteer work on the town board with significant contributions.
